Dear Parents,

Your ward will soon be stepping from the Primary to the Middle level of the School. "The change is inevitable" and a child has to go through the various stages of development in his/her life. So, here are some valuable points for the session 2019 - 2020.

From the academic year of 2017-18, CBSE has decided to restore Board Examination for class X and have advised the Schools to follow a similar pattern for classes VI-IX.

Accordingly, a change in the system of Examination has been proposed and this is to make you aware of the changes, so that you can prepare your ward accordingly.

1. An academic year has been divided into 2 terms - Term - I & Term-II.
2. Each term will have 2 cycle of unit tests. One cycle of unit tests will be of 40 marks and the second one will be of 80 marks.
3. It is mandatory for a student to appear in all the unit tests. A student would have to obtain at least 33% marks in internal assessments (DA & Projects) to be eligible to qualify the examination.
4. The maximum marks of mid term & final term exams will be 80 marks.
5. In final examination the aggregate percentage will be calculated as follows : -

EXAM	MARKS
Final Exam	80
Internal Assessment	5
Lab / project / assessment	5
Test Assessment (Unit Tests)	10
Total	100

6. Classes VI -IX final exam will be held in the School. **Class-X Final Board Examination** will be held by CBSE.
7. Marks and Grades will be awarded for individual subjects and each subsequent unit test / exam will have cumulative syllabus.
8. Co Scholastic activities and Discipline will be graded on a scale of A - E.
9. The third language, **Sanskrit / Punjabi** will be a main subject now. In order to qualify for the next class the student will also have to qualify in the third language. **No change** will be allowed after 1st April, 2019 for the **session 2019-2020**.
10. **Disciplinary Cards** are being issued to the students for serious infringement of rules, like driving in School uniform, carrying cell phones, ipods, objectionable material etc. These cards are to be taken seriously as they have a bearing on the performance of the students. The issue of a disciplinary card will also **find mention** in the certificates being issued to the student during his/her stay and also on seeking transfer/leaving the School.
11. Parents please note that child will be required to be regular in attendance, assignments, projects, assessments & tests etc. So, we expect your cooperation in your child's regularity and continuous good performance throughout the year.

These values will have a bearing on the student's result and for his / her promotion.
