India — a land of culture and grace, Of unity in diversity, a proud embrace. Yet beneath this beauty lies unseen, A truth so dark, a phase so mean.


Rape cases rise, yet voices fade, Women's safety — a promise unmade. Do they deserve this endless pain? Where justice sleeps, corruption reigns.
